Clinical signs				

1. Dyspnea only under the increased physical activity
2. Ascites
3. Tachycardia only under the expressed physical activity
4. Cyanosis (acrocyanosis)
5. Fatigability after unusual work
6. Dyspnea after a moderate physical activity
7. Swellings of lower extremities appearing in the evening
8. Cirrhosis of the liver
9. Dyspnea with a little physical exertion, often at rest
10. Hydrothorax
11. Tachycardia, even at rest
12. Hepatomegalia
13. Rales in lungs
14. Hydropericarditis
15. At night a patient can experience events of asthma, the physical activity can lead to development of the lung edema
16. Reduced daytime diuresis
17. Dyspnea at rest
18. Tachycardia in a moderate physical activity
19. Cough often at night
20. A sudden loss of weight with degenerative changes of the internal organs
21. Constant swellings on legs
