- 4. What are the laboratory and instrumental methods for diagnosing the gastrointestinal tract diseases?
- 5. Define the concepts of "chronic atrophic gastritis", "chronic non-atrophic gastritis associated with H. pylori", "peptic gastric ulcer and duodenal ulcer", "functional dyspepsia", "chronic pancreatitis", "gastroesophageal reflux disease".
