1. What are the main complaints specific to patients with diseases of the blood system?
2. Describe the discoloration of the skin that is characteristic of patients with diseases of the blood system.
3. List and characterize the syndromes observed in diseases of the hematopoietic system.
4. List the clinical signs that are pathognomonic for iron deficiency anemia.
5. What are the clinical and laboratory signs that allow to distinguish the vitamin B12 and folate deficiency?
6. Indicate the main clinical and laboratory signs of hemolytic anemia.
7. Explain what factors in hemolytic anemia contribute in development of jaundice?
8. What complication of the biliary tract is possible due to hemolytic anemia? Explain why it is developing?
9. What are the clinical and laboratory indicators that allow to determine the type of leukemia?
10. Indicate the syndromes that manifest as secondary complications of leukemia.
11. What are the symptoms of the hematopoietic system diseases, for the elimination of which the pharmacist may recommend OTC drugs.
12. Give the clinical and pharmaceutical characteristics of oral and parenteral iron-containing drugs.
13. List the criteria of the evaluation of the effectiveness of treatment of iron deficiency anemia.
14. Give a comparative description of anti-leukemic drugs.
15. Indicate the main groups of drugs that negatively affect hemopoiesis.
